Definition:

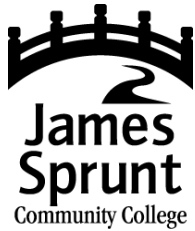
- “Homeless” means lacking fixed, regular and adequate housing, which includes living in shelters, motels or cars, or temporarily living with other people because you have nowhere else to go.
- “Unaccompanied” means you are not living in the physical custody of your parent or guardian.
- “Youth” means you are 23 years of age or younger.

Please provide one or more of the following to prove your current homeless status and write a detailed statement about your current situation. Please include how you currently support yourself

1. A letter from an emergency shelter program funded by the Dept of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) or a letter from the director or employee of a runaway or homeless youth basic center, or transitional living program.
2. A letter from a McKinney-Vento School District Liaison
3. A letter from two individuals, such as guidance counselor, pastor, etc who are aware of your situation, including their phone numbers.
