

Financial Aid

FAFSA is the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. Students must apply online at www.studentaid.gov or visit the Financial Aid Office for assistance with completing the application. The JSCC School code is 007687. To be considered for financial aid, you must graduate from a regionally accredited high school or complete an Adult High School or High School Equivalency (HSE) program.

Priority dates to ensure Financial Aid will be processed in time to pay tuition:

- **Fall: July 1st**
- **Spring: December 1st**
- **Summer: May 1st**

VA Benefits are available to veterans of the US Armed Forces and their eligible dependents.

Private Loans are available to students.

The Finish Line Grants Program aims to help students complete their training when facing unforeseen financial hardships. Finish Line Grants can be used for course materials, housing, medical needs, dependent care, or other financial emergencies that students face through no fault of their own.

Emergency Loans is a loan program available to James Sprunt Community College students for unseen expenses related to your cost of attendance. Students must have a 2.0 GPA or higher to apply and may borrow up to \$1,500 per semester. This loan can be used towards books or tuition, not both. The loan must be paid back before students can register for classes for the next semester and is due in full before the last day of the current semester.

James Sprunt Community College has a limited number of scholarships awarded each year that range from \$250-\$1,200. The application period begins in January and runs through May 5th.
